Below are the details of the up-coming events for April 2019.

Spring is the best time for cleaning our paths and so we are hoping for a good turnout for this month's events. Do please try and get along if you can !

The Yellow Brick Road event has been registered under the 'Great British Spring Clean' banner run by the Keep Britain Tidy organisation.

Floop clean-up

When : **Thursday 11th April** at 10.00 am for registering/briefing.

Where : Start at Longford Rd W bridge which is just east of Highfield Country Park/Nelstrop Rd N.

Car parking is available on Swinburne Green (150 m along Longford Rd over the bridge in the Reddish direction, on the right).

Objective : Head towards Gorton/Debdale - this is a well used part of the Floop and hence requires a continuous effort to keep it in the way we want it for users.

In addition, recent tree cutting by Sustrans has exposed old litter that now can be removed.

Lead volunteer : Chris Parkinson has kindly agreed to lead this event as I will be away

Equipment will be provided as required but suitable clothing and boots should be worn.

Since efficient litter picking often involves working in small groups, we may have a social get-together at the end of the session if there is a demand.

If the weather forecast is particularly bad (e.g. if it looks like continuous heavy rain) then the event may be cancelled at the last minute but this will only be done in exceptional circumstances.
