

As Friends of the Fallowfield Loop/Sustrans volunteers, we are making a determined effort to get the FLOOP free of litter and maintain it so. The next upcoming event is one of two annual clean-ups of the whole FLOOP. This will only be successful if enough people vote with their feet and their hearts and show up over the weekend to do a few hours litter picking. The other events are monthly litter picks on parts of the FLOOP taking place every second Thursday of the month. This is a new venture and we are hopeful it will gain support so that the FLOOP can always be enjoyed litter-free by the many users it has.

Each event will begin with a registration at the publicised start location on the FLOOP and progress from there. Equipment will be provided if necessary and you will not be expected to dispose of the collected bags of litter. You should turn up dressed for the weather wearing suitable footwear (boots recommended) and a hi-vis jacket if you have one. If you just want to come along for the walk that would be fine too.

At present, we have no plans to provide refreshments but we will try and build in a break. For the monthly sessions, we will probably convene to a pub or have a picnic at the end of the session depending on the wishes of the volunteers.
